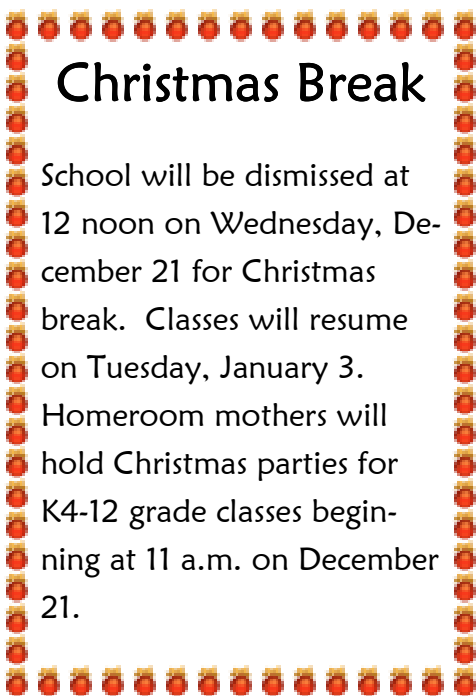
## Coach Ellis Gains 300th Win!

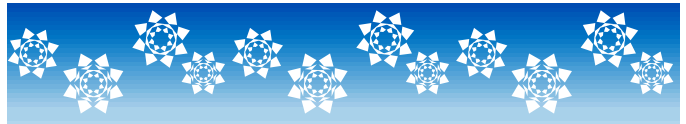
